2022 ANNUAL REPORT



Entering the 2021/22 academic year with so much uncertainty as to how each campus would operate, our leadership here at Oregon Hillel, the Governing Board, and staff continued our commitment to providing each student with the opportunity to explore and express their Jewish identity in the safest possible environment. We took varying protocols on each of our campuses seriously and focused on supporting and caring for students rather than big events and programs. **As the year progressed and restrictions lessened, we continued to listen to our students, understand their passions, and discover what they were looking for from the Jewish community. This allowed us to provide the most impactful experience to them and meet our central mission of building community, inspiring leadership, and connecting students through Jewish values.** Over the course of the year, our Oregon and Oregon State teams worked collaboratively to provide meaningful experiences and support for over 980 students, 120 more than we have ever connected with in the past. We created high-impact Jewish learning and leadership experiences and built deep relationships with nearly 340 students AND quadrupled enrollment in Judaic studies courses at UO thanks to Rabbi Meir's efforts. But it doesn't stop there! We returned to Israel with 50 students on our largest Birthright Israel trip and partnered with Greater Portland Hillel for the first statewide Women's Retreat for Jewish women from universities across the state of Oregon. It was truly an incredible year!

The end of the school year also brought change to Oregon Hillel's team as we bid farewell to three wonderful members of our family: Maddie Schaeffer (Development Associate), Talia Leider (Zidell Family Social Justice Springboard Fellow), and Rachel Chodorow-Reich (Director of Jewish Learning & Spirituality at OSU). We appreciate their years of dedication to our students and our organization's growth. With change comes the excitement of welcoming new individuals to our team of passionate leaders and we know they will all continue the positive work and impact we are making. **The future of Hillel is bright and full of joy. None of this work would have been possible without every alum, parent, friend, foundation, and Federation who so generously gave to invest in our ability to support students at the University of Oregon and Oregon State University!**

Jewish life is truly flourishing at Oregon State University, even as we navigated the return to in-person classes and events on campus, Oregon Hillel was able to connect with over 200 Beavers, reaching more than 30% of the expected 500 Jewish undergraduate and graduate students. **Every week we'd meet a new student interested in connecting with the Jewish community on campus.** Jewish students are choosing OSU because they can attend a great school with a growing dedicated support system for Jewish life and learning.

As we worked to adapt to the return of in-person programming, we were able to host 90 students for an incredible Hanukkah party in the Memorial Union. Our students worked hard to create a Challah Bake event for close to 50 Beavers that received praise from the OSU administration. Our students were thrilled to be back together!

We empowered our students to discover different ways to involve the greater community and gave them new avenues to explore their Jewish identities. This included introducing a new cohort of 15 students who studied the history of anti-Semitism and together with a cohort from the UO, discussed the history of the Holocaust through the Max Goodman Holocaust Education Series taught by Rabbi Meir.

We took a trip to a Quince Orchard to learn the history of the superfruit that's common in Israel and the similarities between Judaism and the Baha'i faith. We offered a number of different opportunities to celebrate Shabbat, ranging from traditional observances to gathering as a community to mark the end of another busy week in college.

Our goal is, and always has been, to make OSU a place where Jews are not only welcome but where there is a vibrant and thriving Jewish community. We can't wait to build on our growth from last year as we welcome a second full-time professional, Michala Katz (Zidell Family Ezra Jewish Education Springboard Fellow), to introduce new opportunities for Jewish learning and spiritual growth for our Beaver community.

The 2021/22 school year was a truly special experience at UO. Not knowing how the year would be impacted by the return to in-person classes and easing of COVID restrictions, we continued to focus on the well-being of students and creating a supportive, caring, and healthy environment for students to reconnect. Through this approach and continually adapting each day, we were able to engage 780 students, reaching over 30% of the expected 2000 Jewish Ducks on campus.

As we like to say at Oregon Hillel, we care more about the people than the programs, and many of these students were met through 1-on-1 meetings (coffee, lunch, walks through campus) with a Hillel staff member. These personal connections allow us to know our students better, their ideas, and their overall needs in order to shape our work. Our staff is able to mentor students and support the creation of their community through new projects that help deepen their connection to Judaism. One example of this is the ScoGreen Composting and Recycling initiative that helped students in dorms or apartments access composting resources that will be used to support a new garden at Hillel! The list goes on... we started a new student led Social Justice Cohort which is a 10 week series focused on addressing social issues across campus and Eugene, culminating in our first student led Mitzvah Day, a joint Israeli Student Retreat in partnership with Greater Portland Hillel, LGBTQIA+ social hours, Jewish learning cohorts focused on topics ranging from the history of Anti-Semitism, Israeli & Palestinian Conflict, and the Holocaust, and so much more!

Seeing our students feel empowered and supported in creating opportunities for each other and their peers has not only inspired them but has made a profound impact on our entire Oregon Hillel team.
